



FOR CLIMATE

Remove containers, wire, string, rope and tags.

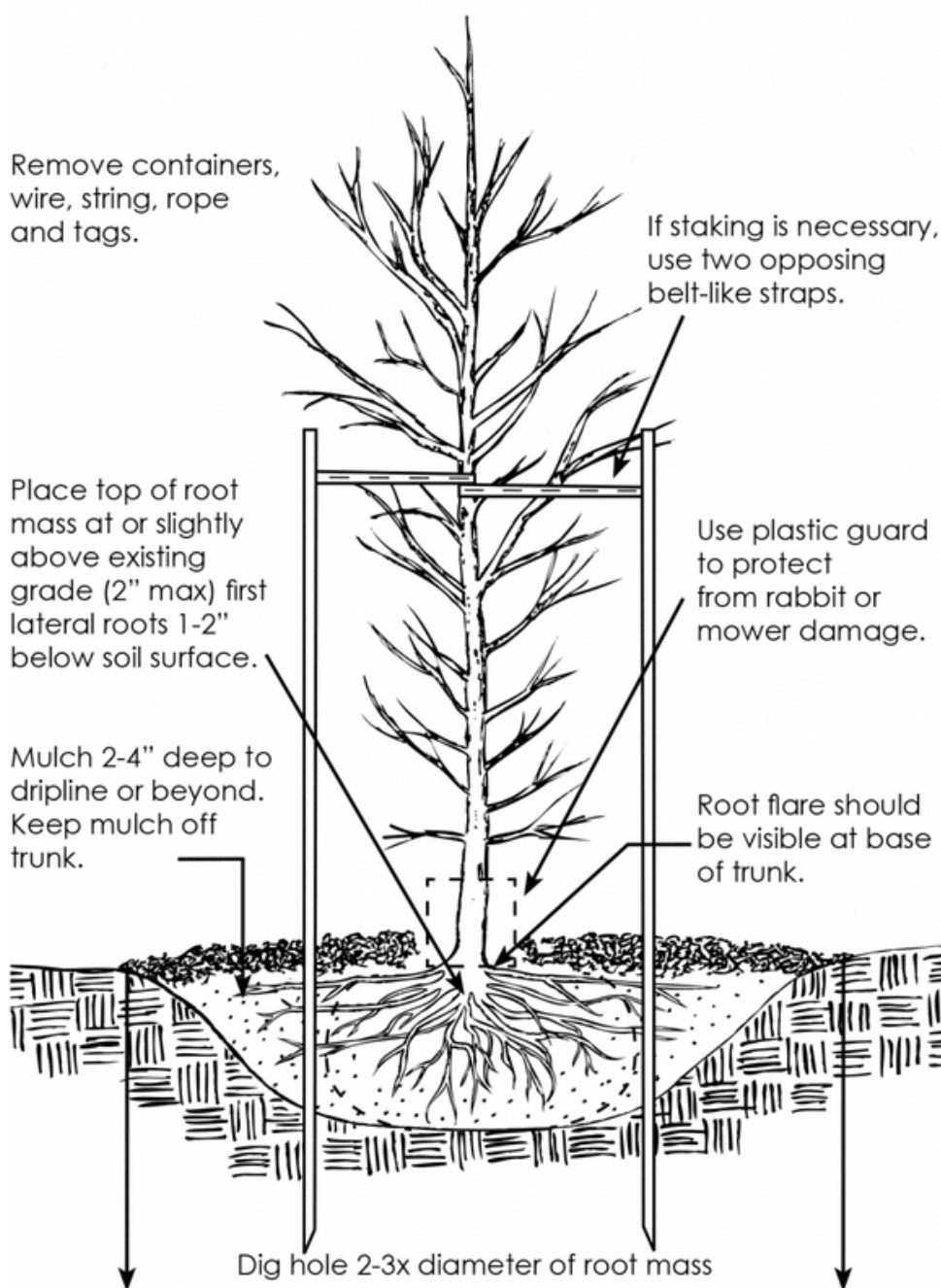
If staking is necessary, use two opposing belt-like straps.

Place top of root mass at or slightly above existing grade (2" max) first lateral roots 1-2" below soil surface.

Use plastic guard to protect from rabbit or mower damage.

Mulch 2-4" deep to dripline or beyond. Keep mulch off trunk.

Root flare should be visible at base of trunk.



Dig hole 2-3x diameter of root mass

PLANT YOUR OWN TREE, PROTECT AND NURTURE IT, HAVE A TREE PET

HOW TO PLANT A TREE?

- Purchase a tree
- Choose an appropriate site
- Dig a hole about 50% larger than the rootball
- Place some water in the hole
- Place the rootball in the hole where the top of the rootball is at the same level as the ground around it
- Backfill with soil, tamp down around the base with your foot, and water

YOU CAN PLANT A SEED AND GET THE TREE

To plant seed instead of an already growing tree, follow this step:

- germinate the seed in the seed container (if needed, soak them 24 hours before)
- sow the seed (if you have many, don't overcrowd them)
- some seeds need to be planted deeper in the growing medium and others shouldn't be covered at all. Check before.
- place the seed container in a room with a temperature between 60 to 80 F (16 to 27 C)
- keep the growing medium moist
- when you see the first green shoots poke through, move the seedlings to a sunny area
- when the growing season begins it will be time to move the seedlings to bigger containers or your outdoor garden.

NOTE: Do you know that if you are planting a tree from the seed of a fruit, that you will not get the same kind of tree?
